- Challenge Goals:
 - Increase the number of tithers
 - Increase the number of giving units in 2022
 - Increase our annual revenue to exceed our initial projection



SJBC Initiatives-God First 90 Day Tithing challenge continued



- 3 levels of giving
 - Grace Giver- this giver is accepting the challenge to give above and beyond the tithes and offerings.
 - Tither- this giver is committing to continue giving God 10% of their earnings.
 - Faith \$50- this person may be saying I don't see how I can give but they want to begin the giving journey by giving \$50.00 a week



GIVING AND REVENUE

- Try the Tithe Sunday (1st Sun. in June and July) is used to teach the principals and benefits of tithing
- Every 2nd Sunday a different leader/ member gave a Tithing Testimony during our Sunday services.
- Mid-Year giving statements mailing and Pastoral giving letter
- Hosting Virtual Financial Workshops with Financial Peace University. Members can access videos at their own pace and gain financial principles.
- Provided \$26,900 in scholarships to 59 high school graduates and recurring college students to provide financial support.
- SJBC congregation has an opportunity to increase what we are giving to the Youth Enhancement Fund (YEF).

COVID PHASE 2

SJBC Phase 2 Re-Entry Phase

- Began baptizing candidates on Sun., Mar. 7 and will continue every 4th Sun.
- Began having communion at the 8 am service starting Sun., April 3rd.
- No funerals, memorial services, or repasts will be held at SJBC at this time.
- Began 2 hybrid Sunday worship services (8:00am and 10:15am), and 1 virtual Sunday worship service (12:00pm) on Easter Sunday, Apr. 17, 2022.

COVID PHASE 2 CONTINUED

- In-person attendee cap for each service: 150 worshippers to register on Eventbrite each week.
- Hybrid Power Hour will be the 1st Wednesday of each month starting in September. Virtual Power Half Hour will be the remaining Wednesdays of each month.
- Bible Study will remain virtual.
- We will continue to evaluate CDC recommendations to determine when to start having funeral and memorial services and hosting repasts. We will re-evaluate afterservice repast in the fellowship hall in the Fall.

COVID PHASE 2 CONTINUED

- In 2020 the entire state of Maryland closed when we reached a 4% positivity rate. Currently, the Maryland Positivity Rate is 10.4%. Therefore, there is still a need for SJBC to have the following COVID Policy.
- Sunday School class spaces in the church (large conf. room, small conf. room, and 3 in the fellowship hall) will be prepared for the 5 hybrid classes that will begin in Phase 3. Sunday School teachers and/or church leaders will be able to test the spaces in preparation for the full rollout. This preparation will include all classrooms being equipped with cameras, mounted monitors, and HDMI wiring.





